Sound Roots – School Handbook Summary

(September 2025)

This handbook is a quick-reference guide for schools. It summarises the key policies for instrumental lessons delivered through Sound Roots.

1. Engagement

- Sound Roots provides fully qualified, vetted tutors (including enhanced DBS).
- The school provides a suitable and safe environment for lessons.

2. Lesson Scheduling

- Lesson times are agreed in advance between Sound Roots and the school.
- If a school must cancel or reschedule, at least 48 hours' notice is required.
- Cancellations with less than 48 hours' notice may still be charged.

3. Notice Period

- Agreements may be ended by either party with 1 full academic term's notice.
- This applies equally to schools and tutors, ensuring fairness.

4. Fees & Payment

- Fees are agreed in writing before services begin.
- Invoices are sent monthly and are payable within 14 days.
- Late payments may incur additional charges.

5. Safeguarding & Supervision

- Tutors follow Sound Roots and school safeguarding procedures.
- Children needing extra supervision must be accompanied by school staff.

6. Confidentiality & Data Protection

- Both parties must keep shared information confidential.
- Sound Roots handles personal data in line with GDPR.

7. Non-Compete

• For 12 months after the end of an agreement, schools must not directly engage or hire Sound Roots tutors without prior written consent.

8. Policy Updates

• Policies may be updated; you'll be informed in writing.
